- 1. Chardonnay Vieilles Vignes** £19.50
Vin de pays d' Oc 2011 (France)
Ripe and rich with a fresh flavoursome finish.

Chico 2013 (Chile)
Crisp and fresh with good fruit, a delightful wine at an excellent price.

- 3. Muscadet de Sevre Et Maine Sur Lie** £19.50
Chateau la Noe 2012 (France)
Fresh, fruity and crisp dry white.
- 4. Pinot Grigio dell Venezia** £18.95
Allamanda 2012/13 (Italy)
Clean and fresh this is an immensely appealing Pinot Grigio.
- 5. Sancerre Domaine des Buissonnes** £28.95
R. Naudet et fils 2012 (France)
This is a delightfully crisp and stylish classic Sancerre.
- 6. Chenin Blanc Millbrook** £17.50
2012/13 (South Africa)
Soft fruit and refreshing acidity on the palate.

Full Bodied White Wines

- 7. Chardonnay** £18.95
Riddle Creek 2012 (Australia)
Tropical fruits on the palate – ripe melon and fig with tangy notes balanced by minimal oak.
- 8. Rioja Blanco** £20.50
Bodegas Viña Valoria 2012 (Spain)
A full and fresh flavour and a long gently oaked finish.

Fruity White Wines

- 9. Sauvignon Blanc Makutu** £26.50
Marlborough 2012/13 (New Zealand)
Typical gooseberry and nectarine aromas with a crisp zingy finish to the palate.
- 10. Viognier Tribu 2012/13 (Argentina)** £18.50
100% Viognier from the Tupungato region of Argentina. A wine with rich fruit flavours of ripe peach, balanced with crisp freshness.
- 11. Riesling Kabinett Klusserather** £18.75
St Michael 2012 (Germany)
Often overlooked and underated, the Riesling grape gives an elegant balance of soft lemon acidity and ripe fruit on the palate.

- 12. St Veran les Terres Secretes** £17.50
Elegant dry white from Burgundy, fine and complex with real style.
- 13. Sancerre Domaine de Buissonnes** £18.50
R. Naudet et fils 2012
Delightful crisp and stylish Sancerre.

Rosé Wines

- 14. Pinot Grigio Rosé Allamanda** £19.50
2012/13 (Italy)
Soft peachy and red fruit notes leading to an off dry finish in the mouth.

- 15. Rosé de Pavail Bordeaux** £23.50
2012 (France)
Flavoursome and smooth with ripe fruit and a good structure.

House Red Wines

- 16. Les Terrasses Merlot/Grenache** £19.50
Ardècheois 2012 (France)
Soft and stylish house red. Bouquet of cherry fruit leading to full rounded palate.

- 17. Cabernet Sauvignon** £19.50
Bodegas Norte Chico 2012/13 (Chile)
A delightful wine, ripe and generous.

Light to Medium Red Wines

- 18. Merlot Momentos** £22.50
Chateau Los Boldos 2012 (Chile)
Subtle plummy fruit with good structure from ageing in French oak barrels.
- 19. Montepulciano d'Abruzzo La Delfina** £18.95
2012 (Italy)
Easy drinking yet flavoursome Italian charmer.
- 20. Pinot Noir Explorer** £20.95
Casablanca Valley 2012/13 (Chile)
Deliciously polished and attractive new world Pinot Noir.
- 21. Regnié Les Rampaux** £25.75
René Passot 2010/11 (France)
An attractive Beaujolais with a light ruby colour, crushed summer fruits and a crisp fruity finish.

Full Bodied Red Wines

- 22. Shiraz/Cinsault Millbrook** £17.95
2012/13 (South Africa)
Unwooded and easy-drinking, showing ripe berries and a smooth finish.
- 23. Carmenere Momentos** £22.75
Chateau los Boldos 2011/12 (Chile)
Indigenous Chilean grape with intense violet colour, aromas of ripe fruit with a hint of coffee. Lightly oaked.
- 24. Château de Seguin Bordeaux** £28.75
Supérieur 2011 (France)
Stylish and classic Claret from a family owned château.
- 25. Reserve Shiraz Rolleston** £20.50
2011 (Australia)
Rich, juicy and packed with flavour, this is a real Aussie charmer.
- 26. Malbec Tanguero 2012/13 (Argentina)** £18.95
Ripe and full flavoured with a lingering finish.

- 27. Rioja Crianza** £26.50
Bodegas Viña Valoria 2010 (Spain)
A business founded in 1860 produces this stylish flavoursome Rioja with plenty of fruit and some oak, giving a rich rounded wine.
- 28. Cabernet Sauvignon Daringa Cellars** £27.75
Mclaren Vale 2006 (Australia)
Deep ruby colour with a nose of blackcurrants and raspberries and a full flavoured yet soft velvety finish.
- 29. Chateau Paveil de Luze** £42.50
Margaux 2007 (France)
Rich truffle and red fruit bouquet to this mature well balanced Bordeaux with a slightly spicy finish.

Half Bottles

- 30. Cotes de Rhone Villages Chusclan** £12.50
Seigneurie de Gicon 2012 (France)
Full flavoured red from the Rhone. Gentle spice with an earthy character. Good value.
- 31. Chateau St Christophe** £23.50
Bordeaux St Emilion 2006 (France)
A fine St Emilion from a family owned Chateau. Ripeness with maturity.

Champagne

- 32. Veuve Clicquot Brut N/V** £55.75
Founded in 1772, and named after the widow of the founder - Madame Cliquo Ponsardin. A blend of 50 Crus with over 50% of the blend Pinot Noir, giving the wine "forcefulness with finesse".
- 33. Champagne Joseph Perrier** £39.75
Cuvee Royale Brut N.V.
Classic blend of Pinot and Chardonnay giving a very accessible fruity style of Champagne.

Sparkling Wines

- 34. Quartet Louis Roederer Estate** £39.75
Anderson Valley (California)
From 4 distinct vineyards, this is a 70:30 blend of Chardonnay and Pinot Noir producing a crisp, elegant Roederer style with great finesse.
- 35. Prosecco Lunetta (Italy)** £24.95
A stylish, fragrant wine with aromas of apple and peach and a clean crisp finish.
- 36. Marquis de la Cour Rosé (France)** £24.95
A Rosé pink with fine bubbles and a red fruit aroma of raspberries and red currants. Subtle fruity finish.

Dessert Wine

- 37. Mistela Castell de Siurana** £19.75
Dessert wine - 50cl (Spain)
A fruity and intense red dessert wine - fabulous.
